

PROCES VERBAL OF CANVASS OF RETURNS  
FOR TOWN OF CHATHAM, LOUISIANA

On this 14th day of October, 1986, at a regular meeting of the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Chatham, Louisiana, said meeting being held in open session and being called to order at 7:00 o'clock P.M. at the Chatham Town Hall by the Mayor,   3   Aldermen being present, for the purpose of canvassing the returns from the Sales Tax Proposition having been submitted to the voters of the Town of Chatham on Saturday, September 27, 1986; the Mayor opened one (1) package previously presented to him by the Honorable Ann B. Walsworth, Clerk of Court in and for Jackson Parish, Louisiana; the package containing a certified copy of the computer printout reflecting the results of the above said election; the Mayor examined the results of the Sales Tax Proposition and declared the vote to be 65 in favor of the proposition and 108 against the proposition, the results then being examined in turn by the Aldermen present, being \_\_\_\_\_ of the Aldermen of the Town of Chatham, Louisiana; the Mayor and each of the Aldermen being in agreement with the above said results, the Sales Tax Proposition was declared to have been defeated by a vote of 65 for and 108 against.

The returns for the proposition having been duly examined and canvassed, no opposition having been made thereto; the Mayor and Board of Aldermen unanimously accepted the results reflected herein as the official results of the proposition election and do hereby declare this to be their proces verbal of said canvass of returns, this 14th day of October, 1986.


RESULTS OF SPECIAL ELECTION FOR  
TOWN OF CHATHAM, LOUISIANA


