PERSONALLY CAME AND APPEARED:

JOHN TRUETT McBRIDE and ELIZABETH ANN SOUR McBRIDE, husband and wife, presently living and residing together, never having been judicially separated or divorced, whose address is 3525 N. Market, Shreveport, Louisiana 71107; and

TOWN OF CHATHAM, herein represented by its Mayor, herein authorized by the provisions of Ordinance No. N/A, passed and adopted at a meeting of the Town Council, held on the — day of —, 1988, and approved by the Mayor on the same day;

who declared they have agreed as follows. Appearers declare that they take cognizance of the provisions of the aforesaid Ordinance No. N/A, and accordingly, JOHN TRUETT McBRIDE and ELIZABETH ANN SOUR McBRIDE, do by these presents, transfer, assign, set over, grant and dedicate to and in favor of the TOWN OF CHATHAM, and the inhabitants thereof, represented by the said Mayor, here present and accepting said dedication, the property described in the said Ordinance, which property is described as follows:

A fifteen foot (15') right-of-way for sewer easement with the centerline of said servitude being described as follows:

Commencing at a point that is 70.36' South and 63.88' East of the Northeast corner of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 2, Township 15 North, Range 1 West, Jackson Parish, Louisiana, thence run N 14 degrees 56 minutes E for a distance of 200', more or less, to a point on the North boundary of the John T. McBride property and to the end of said sewer easement.

The consideration for said dedication is the public convenience and necessity, and the advantages accruing to dedicator by virtue thereof. The above described property is hereby dedicated to public use as a sewage servitude.
