The following ordinance was offered by Delton Spillers who moved its adoption.

AN ORDINANCE TO OPT OUT OF THE DOTTIE SYSTEM UNDER LA R.S. 40:1749.14 BY THE TOWN OF CHATHAM.

Be it enacted by the Town of Chatham that:

SECTION 1: Resolution: That on December 12, 1989 in regular session, the Town of Chatham resolved to "OPT OUT" of the Dottie System, Inc. as provided for by Louisiana Revised Statutes.

SECTION 2: Ordinance: That in accordance with said resolution above mentioned in Section 1, the Town of Chatham does hereby ordain to "OPT OUT" or not be included under the provisions of LA R.S. 40:1749.14 as formally required by law.

Section 3: Filing of Ordinances: That in accordance with Law this Ordinance shall be filed forthwith with the Secretary of State, State of Louisiana for verification purposes.

SECTION 4: Should any section or provision of this Ordinance be declared to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not effect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any other part thereof.

SECTION 5: Other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption. This ordinance was offered by Delton Spillers and seconded by Mike Wilson and was read and as read, considered Section by Section and finally adopted as a whole, by the following vote:
